Fraud and ethics expert, former felon and Author of *Diary of a White Collar Criminal*

For over 2 years his name was, Federal Inmate Number 08657-041. Before that, Jerome Mayne was the founder and CEO of two corporations, respected in the financial community and the father of two young boys. In 1999 he received a 21-month prison sentence for conspiracy to commit mail fraud, wire fraud and money laundering – crimes that took place four years earlier. On November 4th, 1999, he reported to the Federal Prison in Yankton, South Dakota and his career and his life were changed forever.

For the past 15 years Jerome has been speaking on fraud and ethics for associations and Fortune 500 companies in Canada, Mexico and the United States.

He has appeared on numerous panels, radio shows and web-cast productions as a self-taught expert on fraudulent behavior. He has been a contributing columnist for the California CPA Magazine and the Business Journal. He is the author of the book *Diary of a White Collar Criminal*, and real estate continuing education course *Mortgage Fraud and Predatory Lending – what every agent should know* (Dearborn/Kaplan).

He is also an instructor and performer of improvisational and stand-up comedy.
